COVID VACCINATION & MASK POLICY

Boskone has updated its COVID Vaccine and Mask Policy given the new mandates passed by the City of Boston. These changes place Boskone's policy in line with local government regulations.

We believe that Boskone's updated policy will make the convention an even safer and more comfortable place for all of our members, participants, and staff to attend in person.

Boskone 59 Covid Vaccine and Mask Policy:

- All people physically attending Boskone, 5 years old and older, must be fully vaccinated and show proof of vaccination. There are no exceptions.
- All people 2 years old or older [attending Boskone] must wear a mask in convention spaces (including open parties) at all times, except when eating or drinking in designated food and drink spaces. There are no exceptions.
- Children 4 and under must be with parents or guardians at all times and have a negative PCR test taken February 15 or later.
