Our convention hotel is **The Westin Boston Seaport District**.  
All guest rooms include in-room WiFi as well as free WiFi in the lobby area.

### Reservations for our block rate are available now.

Make your booking soon to be sure you don't miss out. The block rates will be good through **January 22, 2026**, or until the block is sold out.

*NOTE:* Boskone's room block almost always sells out. So, please book your room early.

### NEW FOR BOSKONE: THE PORTABLE PLANETARIUM

Hal Clement Science Speaker [Diego Patrimonio](#) has arranged for a portable planetarium to come to Boskone. Welcome to the great age of searching for planets outside of our solar system! From successful planet finder missions CoRoT, Kepler, TESS and others, detecting alien worlds is no longer science fiction. Thirty-minute shows will run on Saturday and Sunday and are open to all ages. No advance sign-up is required; if a show is full, you will receive a timed ticket for a later session. While seating is primarily on the floor, we can accommodate wheelchairs or chairs for those with different mobility abilities. Additionally, a special Solar System show for children attending DragonsLair will be held Saturday at 1:00 PM.



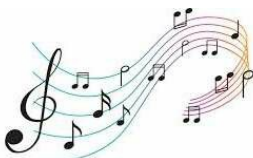
### OFFICIAL ARTIST SPECIAL WORKSHOP

## BOSKONE 63 POLICIES

### Boskone 63 (2026) Respiratory Diseases (including COVID) Policy

(Policy as of November 8, 2025, final policy will be posted in January 2026)

Boskone 63 recommends, but does not require, that in-person members wear masks in convention spaces. We also recommend, but do not require, that in-person attendees be up to date on their seasonal vaccines (COVID-19, Influenza, etc). We also recommend that in-person attendees wash hands regularly and adhere to the 5-2-1 rule (Get at least five hours of sleep, eat at least 2 meals per day, and shower daily). If possible, test for COVID-19 before coming to the convention. If you are feeling unwell, or test positive for COVID-19, please do not come to Boskone, contact us ([registration@boskone.org](mailto:registration@boskone.org)) by Monday, February 16th, 2026 and we will roll your membership over to next year.

### Food Policy

Due to hotel restrictions, no outside food or drinks are allowed in function spaces. This includes the Galleria (Art Show, Autographing, Dealers Room, Fan Tables, Office), Harbor & Marina Foyers, Game Room, Video Room, and any Program Rooms. Drinks and light snacks will be available in the Consuite on the 16th Floor. While food and drinks purchased from the hotel are generally allowed, some spaces may have additional rules in place in order to protect various materials and equipment. These additional rules will be posted outside the spaces in question.
